- High** – DJ provides music and MC service according to the itinerary provided by the bride and groom. The actual sequence and timing of events is handled by the DJ in accordance with written instructions by the bride & groom but subject to reasonable delays due to activities taking longer than expected. (ex. Bouquet toss scheduled to end at 7PM but takes until 7:15 to complete).

A typical song is 4 minutes long. A good rule to follow is that we will be able to play a maximum of 15-20 songs per hour of your reception including the specific activity songs listed above. In a 4 hour reception an **absolute maximum** of 80 songs is possible assuming that some of the songs are shorter than 4 minutes. Any music on this list will **absolutely be available at your reception and will have priority to be played**. To insure that the songs most important to you are played, please list the songs in order of priority. If time constraints keep us from playing all of the songs on your list the lower priority songs are the songs that will be dropped from your event.

If there are certain songs that you absolutely do not want to hear at your event please list them here. They will not be available at your event. If requested by one of your **the DJ will not have these songs available to play.**
